WHEREAS:


- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. Section 1 (B) the Navajo Nation Council delegates to all Navajo Nation Chapters governmental authority with respect to local matters consistent with Navajo law, including custom and tradition; and**
- 2. Dennehotso Chapter is aware of the need for a Navajo Nation-wide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System for any sudden occurrences of emergencies, and recognizes the lack of an effective emergency responses; and**
- 3. Dennehotso Chapter acknowledges the need for establishment of an Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communications and expedite emergency services; and**
- 4. Furthermore, Dennehotso Chapter genuinely believes those communities within the Navajo Nation, with established Rural Addressing Systems and the Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System, will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personnel and police districts.**

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Dennehotso Chapter hereby respectfully submits its support and endorsement of the implementation of a Rural Addressing System, and subsequently, a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System; an effort by and through the Communications and Utilities Department of the Navajo Division of General Services.
