RESOLUTION OF THE JEDDITO CHAPTER

JEDD-01-16-07-006

SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING THE COMPLETION OF A RURAL ADDRESSING SYSTEM AND THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A NAVAJO NATION ENHANCED 9-1-1 SYSTEM.

WHEREAS:

1. The Jeddito Chapter, pursuant to 26 NNC Section 3(A), is a duly certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation as listed under 26 N.N.C., Part 1, Section 10; and
2. The Jeddito Chapter, pursuant to 26 NNC Section 1(B) is delegated the governmental authority to make decisions over local matters consistent with Navajo laws, customs, and tradition; and
3. The Jeddito Chapter, is aware of the need for a Navajo Nation-wide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System for any sudden occurrences of emergencies and recognizes the lack of an effective emergency response; and
4. The Jeddito Chapter, acknowledges the need for establishment of an enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communications and expedite emergency services; and
5. The Jeddito Chapter, genuinely believes those communities within the Navajo Nation will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personnel and police districts.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Jeddito Chapter, hereby respectfully submits its support and endorsement in the implementation of a Rural Addressing System, commitment to help maintain the accuracy and subsequently, a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System, an effort by and through the Communications and Utilities Department of the Navajo Division of General Services.
