Resolution of the Sawmill Chapter

Supporting and Endorsing the Completion of a Rural Addressing System and the Development and Implementation of a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System.

Whereas:

1. Pursuant to 26 NNC, section 3(a), the Sawmill Chapter is a certified chapter of the Navajo Nation as listed under 11 NNC part 1, section 10 ; and
2. Pursuant to 26 NNC, section 1(b), the Sawmill Chapter is delegated the governmental authority to make decisions over local matters consistent with Navajo law, custom, and tradition ; and
3. The Sawmill Chapter is aware of the needs for a Navajo Nation-wide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System for any sudden occurrences of emergencies and recognizes the lack of an effective emergency response; and
4. The Sawmill Chapter acknowledges the need for establishment of an Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communication and expedite emergency services; and
5. Furthermore, the Sawmill Chapter genuinely believes those communities within the Navajo Nation will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personal and police district.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOVLED THAT:


