Resolution: CBN-9-26-06-68:

Resolution of the Canoncito Band of Navajos (To'Hajiilee) supporting and endorsing the Completion of a Rural Addressing System and the Development and Implementation of a Navajo Nation Wide Enhanced 9-1-1 Emergency System:

WHEREAS:

- 1. The To'Hajiilee Chapter is a recognized governing entity of the Navajo Nation located within the Bernalillo County New Mexico as a satellite community; and
- 2. The To'Hajiilee Chapter is aware of the need for a Navajo Nation Wide Enhanced 9-1-1 Emergency System for any sudden occurrences of emergencies, and recognized the lack of an effective emergency response; and
- 3. The To'Hajiilee Chapter acknowledges the need for establishment of a Navajo Nation Wide enhanced 9-1-1 Emergency System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communications and expedite emergency services; and
- 4. Furthermore, the To'Hajiilee Chapter genuinely believes those communities within Navajo Nation will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personnel and police district.
