### WHEREAS:

- 1. The Pine Dale Chapter is duly recognized Navajo Chapter governing entity of the Navajo Nation with certain responsibilities for local people advocacy on improvements; and
- 2. The Pine Dale Community is located between Crownpoint and Gallup without immediate response to emergencies/urgencies nor has community ready response team or medical setting within reasonable distance other than distance of more than twenty pavement mileage, waiting period of more than thirty to forty-five minutes; and
- 3. The Pine Dale Chapter recognizes the immediate need for response time for urgencies/emergencies that may save lives with quick journeys medical facilities; and
- 4. The Pine Dale Chapter and community as a whole has worked with the McKinley County Rural Addressing but the County Program did not have long term effect, no maintenances or up keep of the program that is idle;
- 5. The Pine Dale Chapter has experienced long and hard in dealing with negative immediate care needs, does endorsed the intent of the Navajo Nation Government Service Committee on development of 9-1-1 emergency system with Rural Addressing; and

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Pine Dale Chapter hereby fully endorses and supports the intent of the Navajo Nation Government Service Committee Resolution # **GSCJA-09-03** on its rural Addressing completion and implementation of the Emergency 9-1-1 System.
