# SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING THE COMPLETION OF A RURAL ADDRESSING SYSTEM AND THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTING OF A NAVAJO NATION ENHANCED EMERGENCY 9-1-1- SYSTEM.

- 1. The COVE CHAPTER is a recognized governing entity of the Navajo Nation located within boundaries of the Navajo Nation. It is endowed with perennial responsibilities to advocate for its citizen and community within the Navajo Nation; and
- The COVE CHAPTER is aware of the need for a Navajo Nation-wide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System.
- The COVE CHAPTER acknowledges the need for established of an Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communities and expedite emergency services; and
- 4. Furthermore, the COVE CHAPTER genuinely believes those communities within Navajo Nation will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personnel and police district.
