# RESOLUTION OF THE HOUCK CHAPTER

Supporting and Endorsing the Completion of a Rural Addressing System and the Development and Implementation of a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System.

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. The Houck Chapter is a recognized governing entity of the Navajo Nation located within the boundaries of the Navajo Nation. It is endowed with perennial responsibilities to advocate for its citizens and community within the Navajo Nation; and
- 2. The Houck Chapter is aware of the need for a Navajo Nation-wide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System for any sudden occurrences of emergencies, and recognizes; and
- 3. The Houck Chapter acknowledges the need for establishment of an Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communications and expedite emergency services; and
- 4. Furthermore, the Houck Chapter genuinely believes those communities within Navajo Nation will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personnel and police district.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Chapter hereby respectfully submits its support and endorsement in the implementation of a Rural Addressing System, commitment to help maintain the accuracy and subsequently, a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System, an effort by and through the Communications an Utilities Department of the Navajo Division of General Services.
