- 1. The Kinlichee Chapter is a recognized governing entity of the Navajo Nation located within the boundaries of the Navaio Nation. It is endowed with perennial responsibilities to advocate for its citizens and community within the Navajo Nation; and
- 2. The Kinlichee Chapter is aware of the need for a Navajo Nation-wide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System for any sudden occurrences of emergencies, and recognizes
- 3. The Kinlichee Chapter acknowledges the need for establishment of an Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communications and expedite emergency services; and
- 4. Furthermore, the Kinlichee Chapter genuinely believes those communities within Navajo Nation will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personnel and police district.
- 5. A Rural Addressing System was initiated through the Division of Public Safety and numbers were assigned to housing structures throughout the community, however, since then some of these rural addressing signs have deteriorated or been vandalized and need to be replaced. All new housing structures need to be numbered.
